Jim Heinrich of the Dept. of Fish & Wildlife will present seminars on July 11 from 9-10am, and August 10, August 24 and September 7 from 8 – 9am. After a power point presentation, there will be time for clam digging on the tide flats across from the RV Park.

Be sure to remember your license, bucket and shovel if you plan on digging for clams.
